

**ORDINANCE NO. 2008-4**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE COMMISSION TO APPOINT ALTERNATES ON ANY AND ALL BOARDS AND COMMITTEES OF THE VILLAGE AS IT DEEMS NECESSARY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Commission has created several boards and committees to provide the Commission with assistance in fulfilling the needs of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, certain boards and committees have, at times, experienced problems with reaching a quorum at their meetings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Commission finds it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to allow the appointment of alternates as necessary to increase community participation and to ensure that quorums are met; now, therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park, Florida, as follows:

**Section 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Ordinance upon adoption hereof.

**Section 2.** The Village Commission may appoint alternates to any and all Village Boards and Committees as deemed necessary.

**Section 3.** All previous appointments of alternates are retroactively approved by this Ordinance.


**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

The foregoing Ordinance was offered by Commissioner Anderson, who moved its adoption.


The motion was seconded by Vice-Mayor Morris and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
