

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE 2006-7 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 26, 2006 BY AMENDING THE BUDGET TO TRANSFER FUNDING FROM ACCOUNT 519 ENTITLED GENERAL GOVERNMENT TO ACCOUNT 534 ENTITLED PUBLIC WORKS, CONSISTENT WITH THE APPROVED PAINTER'S UNION CONTRACTS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Village of Biscayne Park's Charter and all laws of the State of Florida, on September 26, 2006, the Village Commission finalized and adopted its General Fund budget for fiscal year 2006-2007; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission acknowledges that, consistent with the approval of a new painter's union contract, an amendment is required to the General Fund budget as provided for in Exhibit "A," attached hereto;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Each and all the foregoing Whereas clauses are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The General Fund budget for fiscal year 2006-2007 approved by the Village Commission on September 26, 2006 is amended as provided for in Exhibit "A," attached hereto.

Section 3. The Village Commission hereby ratifies and confirm all other provisions of Ordinance 2006-7.


Section 4. Conflicts. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption on second reading.

The foregoing Ordinance was offered by Commissioner Anderson, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walker and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:




