



ORDINANCE No. 2006-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, **ESTABLISHING THE 2006-2007 MILLAGE RATE OF 9.20 MILLS PER EACH \$1,000 OF ASSESSED VALUATION UPON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, The Village of Biscayne Park Commission received the Certification of Taxable Value on personal property from the Miami Dade County Property Appraiser who certified the gross taxable value for operating purposes to be \$193,380,407 and

WHEREAS, pursuant to F.S. 200.065, the Village of Biscayne Park held two Public Hearings, the first on the 12TH day of September, 2006 and the Second on the 25TH day of September, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Millage rate was presented at both public hearings and all interested persons were given the opportunity to voice their comments,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park, Florida, that:


- Section 1.** The FY 2006-2007 operating millage rate for the Village of Biscayne Park is set at **9.20 mills per each \$1,000** of assessed value, as certified by the Miami Dade County Property appraiser, as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for 2006-2007, and which is 37.65% greater than the rolled-back rate of 6.6835 mills.
- Section 2.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Ordinance to the Dade County Tax Collector; the State of Florida Department of Revenue and any other parties as required by law.
- Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


