ORDINANCE NO. 2013-11

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE
COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF
BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING
THE 2013-2014 MILLAGE RATE AT 9.70 MILS
FOR EACH \$1,000 OF ASSESSED VALUATION
UPON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY
WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE
VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

15 WHEREAS, the Village of Biscayne Park Commission received the Certificate of
16 Taxable Value on real and personal property from the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser
17 who certified the gross taxable value for operating purposes to be \$132,618,518; and

18 WHEREAS, pursuant to F.S. 200.065, the Village of Biscayne Park held two Public
19 Hearings, the first on the 11th day of September, 2013, and the second on the 24th day of
20 September 2013; and

21 WHEREAS, the millage rate was presented at both public hearings and all interested
22 persons were given the opportunity to voice their comments.

23 NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Village Commission of the Village of
24 Biscayne Park, Florida, that:

25 **Section 1.** The FY 2013-2014 operating millage rate for the Village of Biscayne Park is
26 set at 9.70 mils per each \$1,000 of assessed value, as certified by the Miami-Dade County Property
27 Appraiser, as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for the 2011 calendar year,
28 and which is 5.40% greater than the rolled-back rate of 9.2027 mils.

29 **Section 2.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Ordinance
30 to the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector; the State of Florida Department of Revenue and any
other parties as required by law.

1 **Section 3.** The Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

3 The foregoing Ordinance was offered by Commissioner Ross, who moved its adoption. The
4 motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Anderson and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as
5 follows:




