5 A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF
6 THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA,
7 AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO APPLY
8 FOR THE 2012 FLORIDA URBAN AND COMMUNITY
9 FORESTRY GRANT PROPOSAL THROUGH THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER
11 SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

13 WHEREAS, trees and the diverse tree canopy are an important part of the Village; and

14 WHEREAS, the Village of Biscayne Park desires to apply for the 2012 Florida Urban
15 and Community Forestry Grant which would provide funding for the continued maintenance
16 and care of our tree canopy; and

17 WHEREAS, once funding is approved from the grant, the Village of Biscayne Park will
18 execute a Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement between the Village of Biscayne Park and
19 the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.

21 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSISON OF**
22 **THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA:**

23 **Section 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as
24 being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption
25 hereof.

26 **Section 2.** The Village Commission authorizes the Village Manager to apply for the
27 2012 Florida Urban and Community Forestry Grant which would provide funding for the
28 continued maintenance and care of our tree canopy. The grant application, in substantial form,
29 is attached and incorporated by reference into this resolution as exhibit 1.

31 **Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.






