5 **A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION**
6 **OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA**
7 **DECLARING VILLAGE VEHICLE AS SURPLUS**
8 **PROPERTY AND GRANTING THE VILLAGE**
9 **MANAGER AUTHORIZATION TO SELL SAID**
10 **SURPLUS THROUGH GOV DEALS; PROVIDING FOR**
11 **AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

14 WHEREAS, the Village of Biscayne Park owns a 2001 Ford Crown Victoria that was
15 utilized for several years as a police unmarked investigative vehicle; and,

17 WHEREAS, Village Administration has determined that the 2001 Ford Crown
18 Victoria is no longer serviceable due to the high mileage (185,899) for any service or capacity
19 within the Village; and,

21 WHEREAS, this vehicle is now considered surplus and will be sold through GovDeals,
22 a service provider to various government agencies and municipalities to sell surplus items via
23 the Internet; a standard practice for municipalities throughout the country.

25 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE
26 VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA:

28 **Section 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as
29 being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

31 **Section 2.** The following vehicle is hereby declared surplus property of the Village:


33 **2001 Ford Crown Victoria, Vin# 2FAFP71W71X138399 Mileage 185,899**




