WHEREAS, Intensified Wood Restoration, LLC, the log restoration specialists from Munising, Michigan, that worked on the restoration of the Village’s historic Log Cabin, generously donated a handcrafted replica of the Log Cabin to the Village of Biscayne Park; and,

WHEREAS, the replica is considered a piece of artwork that will be proudly displayed at Village Hall and other Village municipal buildings for the enjoyment of its residents; and,

WHEREAS, public art is well recognized as a tool to express community pride, identity and sense of place, and the Village of Biscayne Park has benefited through previous donations of artwork; and,

WHEREAS, to promote continued generosity and good will, as well as consistency and transparency, the Village subsequently established a Gift and/or Donation Policy, which in part directs that “any art work shall be brought to the Village Council [sic] for acceptance.” and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission finds that acceptance of the Art Donation is consistent with the Village’s public purpose, and is in the best interest of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, that

Section 1. The above-stated recitals are hereby confirmed and adopted.

1 **Section 2.** That, consistent with Resolution No. 2011-30, the Village Manager or designee
2 is hereby authorized to accept the Art Donation on behalf of the Village.

3 **Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

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
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
