1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

2. AGENDA ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS
  - a. Discussion of Peace Poll – Rox Ross request.
3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:
  - a. Minutes - None
4. OLD BUSINESS
  - A. Barbara Kuhl gave a report
    - a. Mario, the new Public Works Director had been at the previous Code meeting and he said that signs were to be installed “No Parking on Median” as a presumed as a necessity for enforcement. The Board members were concerned with sign pollution and preferred that citations were given regardless of the assumption that any tickets given purely on statutes and in the absence of signage would be thrown out by the courts.
  - B. The contract for the maintenance of the athletic field was now in place.
5. NEW BUSINESS –
  - A. Discussion regarding “Little Free Libraries” – Mac Kennedy
    - a. Board approved the idea of creating two libraries (Village Hall and Rec Center) with a plan for maintenance; Mac to develop a plan for the next meeting
  - B. Request from Village Manager for a matching tree planting grant: the board unanimously approves the Village applying for the grant and requests the Village Manager to execute the application; if we get the grant, the board will work with the manager to identify locations for the
  - C. December meeting moved to December 14, 2016
  - D. Added item - Discussion of Peace Poll – Commissioner Rox Ross request. Commissioner Ross asked for advice regarding her proposal for a “Peace Poll”. Charley Easton, an artist, had produced a proposed

drawing that indicated a reference to swords being beaten into plowshares. Members except Randy Wagoner expressed a concern that this Bible verse would be used on a public monument. Various other ideas were discussed – inclusion of faces or doves (again there was some concern for a Biblical reference). The pole could be made of fiberglass as a construction material option. The Log cabin and the new Village hall were discussed as locations for installation. At the close of discussion, the Board made no other recommendation.

6. ADJOURNMENT – The meeting was adjourned.
