

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-2**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THAT MIAMI-DADE COUNTY ALLOW THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COUNTY'S LANDSCAPE BEAUTIFICATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO TRANSMIT THIS RESOLUTION TO THE APPROPRIATE COUNTY OFFICIALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County currently has a program for municipalities in the County known as the Landscape Beautification Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission and its Parks and Parkways Advisory Board desire to participate in the County's Landscape Beautification Assistance Program in order to receive funding to improve the medians along NE 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue/SR-915; and

WHEREAS, in order to become a participant in the Program, the County requires that municipalities adopt a resolution requesting participation; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park finds it to be in the best interests of its citizens to request that Miami-Dade County allow the Village to participate in the County's Landscape Beautification Assistance Program;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:**



**Section 2.** The Village Commission hereby requests that Miami-Dade County allow the Village of Biscayne Park to participate in the County's Landscape Beautification Assistance Program in order to receive funding through the Joint Participation Agreement No. 250610-1-58-1 (JPA) between the County and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the design and installation of landscape improvements along NE 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue/SR-915;

**Section 3.** The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to transmit this Resolution to Miami-Dade County.


**Section 4.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
