**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE
VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA; ACCEPTING
DONATION OF ARTWORK TO THE VILLAGE; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, a group of residents of the Village of Biscayne Park has offered to donate a
an original art sculpture to the Village (the "Art Donation"); and

WHEREAS, the Art Donation includes transportation and delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes that Art in Public Places is strongly encouraged by
Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission of the Village of Biscayne
Park authorize the Village Manager to accept the gift of the original art sculpture by artist
Bilhenry Walker from the residents of the Village as an addition to the Village's Art in Public
Places collection.

WHEREAS, the Village Commission finds that acceptance of the Art Donation is in the
best interest of the Village.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISISON OF THE
VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, THAT:**

Section 1. That the above stated recitals are herby confirmed and adopted.

Section 2. That the Village Manager is hereby authorized to accept the Art Donation on
behalf of the Village, and to put in storage if needed during hurricane season.

Section 3. That the Village Manager is instructed to reach out to residents, Planning
Board, Parks & Parkway Advisory Board, to help her decide where to place the piece of art, then
report back to the Commission on her decision.


