

ORDINANCE No. 2009-5



AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE 2009-2010 MILLAGE RATE **8.8903** MILS PER EACH \$1,000 OF ASSESSED VALUATION UPON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The Village of Biscayne Park Commission received the Certification of Taxable Value on personal property from the Miami Dade County Property Appraiser who certified the gross taxable value for operating purposes to be **\$168,621,920** and

WHEREAS, pursuant to F.S. 200.065, the Village of Biscayne Park held two Public Hearings, the first on the 8th day of September, 2009 and the Second on the 22nd day of September, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Millage rate was presented at both public hearings and all interested persons were given the opportunity to voice their comments,


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park, Florida, that:

- Section 1.** The FY 2009-2010 operating mileage rate for the Village of Biscayne Park is set at **8.8903** mils per each \$1,000 of assessed value, as certified by the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser, as shown on the real and personal property assessment rolls for 2009-2010, and which is not greater than the rolled-back rate of **9.3510** mils.
- Section 2.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Ordinance to the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector; the State of Florida Department of Revenue and any other parties as required by law.
- Section 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

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
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
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
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
