5 **RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION**  
6 **OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK**  
7 **AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO**  
8 **IMPLEMENT A POLICY FOR RECOGNITION OF**  
9 **EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE FOR VILLAGE**  
10 **STAFF; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

13 WHEREAS, Village administration wishes to recognize the exemplary performance of  
14 village staff when their actions go beyond the call of duty; and


15 WHEREAS, an example of such exemplary performance occurred on November 18, 2010,  
16 when Public Works Director Bernard Pratt observed a suspicious, occupied vehicle parked down  
17 the street from the Public Works. Director Pratt, using his crime prevention training under the  
18 Village of Biscayne Park on Patrol (VOBPOP) initiative that was established in the spring of 2010,  
19 called the police department. His actions led to the arrest of an individual who had an outstanding  
20 felony warrant. Additionally, because a ski mask and gloves were found in the vehicle, a probable  
21 crime was prevented from occurring in the Village; and

22 WHEREAS, at the discretion of the Village Manager, such exemplary performance will be  
23 recognized with a paid day off and a fifty-dollar (\$50.00) gift certificate; and

25 WHEREAS, such exemplary performance will be recognized at a commission meeting  
26 where a certificate of appreciation will be awarded by the Mayor and Commission.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE  
29 VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, that this Commission supports the implementation  
30 of this policy to recognize the exemplary performance of Village Staff.


