

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, URGING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY COMMISSION TO ANALYZE COUNTY DEFICIENCIES IN AN EFFORT TO REDUCE EXPENDITURES IN ORDER TO CONTINUE THE SAME SERVICES AND LEVEL OF EMPLOYEES WITHOUT RAISING TAXES; DIRECTING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO TRANSMIT THIS RESOLUTION TO THE MAYOR AND COUNTY COMMISSIONS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Village Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park is aware that Miami-Dade County is considering decreasing its services and employees in order to balance the County's budget; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park also understands that the County Commission is considering raising taxes during these trying economic times; and

WHEREAS, instead of taking the above referenced measures, the Village Commission respectfully requests and urges, prior to adopting its budget, that the County Commission examine all departments in an attempt to realize deficiencies and in order to reduce waste and unnecessary expenses which will allow the County to maintain its level of services and employees without decreasing services to the community or raising taxes; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

Section 2. The Village Commission hereby urges the Miami-Dade County Commission to analyze County deficiencies in an effort to reduce expenditures in order to continue the same services and level of employees without raising taxes.

Section 3. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to transmit this Resolution to the Mayor and County Commissioners of Miami-Dade County.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.




