REGULAR COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:04pm by Mayor Tracy Truppman.

2. ROLL CALL OF THE CITY OFFICIALS:

7.b RFP 2018-01 – Building Permit Review and Inspection Services - Village Manager Manners advised that two companies responded: “Calvin Giordano & Associates, Inc.” and “M2E Consulting Engineers” . Village Manager and North Miami Building Official Steve Pizillo ranked the companies and Calvin, Giordano & Associates Inc. ranked the highest. Rates will be negotiated.

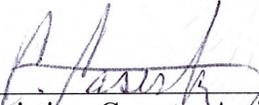
