**AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT TO SERVE AS
TEMPORARY INTERIM CHIEF OF POLICE**

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2017, the Village of Biscayne Park (hereinafter the "Village") and Nick Wollschlager (hereinafter the "Wollschlager") entered into an Agreement to Serve as Temporary Interim Chief of Police, which Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "1" (hereinafter the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of amending the Agreement to amend certain provisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises hereof, the mutual promises and agreements contained herein, and the payments to be made to Wollschlager for services rendered to the Village hereunder, the parties hereby agree as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are acknowledged and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Paragraph 1, entitled "Term", shall be amended to read as follows:

1. TERM. The operative date of this Amendment shall be April 4, 2017, and shall continue and remain in effect until such time as the position of Chief of Police is filled.

Section 3. Paragraph 3, entitled "Compensation", shall be amended to read as follows:

3. COMPENSATION. Wollschlager shall be paid a salary of \$2,733.20 bi-weekly in accord with the Village's regular payroll cycle, and subject to withholding required by law, which is equivalent to the former Chief's bi-weekly payout salary and based on an annual salary of \$71,000.00. When the position of Chief of Police is filled, Wollschlager will return to his current salary as Corporal.

Section 4. All Other Conditions and Terms: All conditions and terms of the Agreement between the Village of Biscayne Park and Nick Wollschlager, executed on December 21, 2016 not specifically amended herein remain in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict, this Amendment will supersede all other terms. In the event of ambiguity, the most conservative interpretation consistent with the public interest is intended.
