

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-49

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE DONATION OF \$2,500 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 TO THE NORTH MIAMI FOUNDATION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS' SERVICES, INC.; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the North Miami Foundation for Senior Citizens Services, Inc. ("Foundation") is a non-profit organization which provides a wide range of assistance for the elderly, including meals on wheels and other services to support independent living; and

WHEREAS, every month residents in northern Miami-Dade County are assisted by the programs and services created and coordinated by the Foundation, including over 1,000 meals and other support services delivered to Biscayne Park residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village Recreation Department and the Foundation collaborate to bring educational and social opportunities for elderly residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village Commission of the Village of Biscayne Park believes it is in the best interest of its citizens to support the Foundation as it is a valuable resource for elderly residents; and

WHEREAS, the allocation made as part of the budget adopted for fiscal year 2016-17 is \$2,500 in General Government, consistent with prior years' donations.






