- **PARKS & RECREATION:**

Parks & Rec Manager worked on Movie Night in the Park preparations. Storage room clean-up and organization. Manager met with Osher Director to discuss programming. Playground maintenance and tot lot clean up. Weekly grounds and building maintenance.



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- **PUBLIC WORKS:**

The Public Works Team mowed Village Hall and the Church Lot, Entrance sign at 113<sup>th</sup> St and NE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave., Rec Center and the Ballfield. Vacuumed leaves and removed debris at the Tot Lot. Planted Molly grass at NE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave Bridge and watered. Repaired broken sprinkler head at NE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave and 119<sup>th</sup> St. Removed dead Palm tree located in the median located at 740 NE 115<sup>th</sup> St.

Removed broken limb from an Oak tree that was hit by a truck located at 666 NE 115<sup>th</sup> St. Repaired lights as needed in the Pavilion at the Rec Center. Placed bench at NE 120 St and 8<sup>th</sup> Ave in the median in coordination with the Public Art Advisory Board. Removed debris in swale as needed for safety concerns. Assisted the Rec Manager in preparation for Movie Night. Installed two delineators at NE 116<sup>th</sup> St and 8<sup>th</sup> Ave eastside as needed for safety concerns.

- **ADMINISTRATION:**

Manager continues to work with the Village Attorney and FEMA regarding debris reimbursement. Attended Swearing In of two new Reserve Officers. Began researching options for new Attorney/firm. Assisted staff and residents as needed.
