- **PARKS & RECREATION:**

Manager met with Marque Northington from the Miami Dolphins organization to discuss a partnership with our Youth Sports Programs. Weekly grounds and building maintenance.

- **PUBLIC WORKS:**

- Daily median maintenance.
- Mowed, weed-eating & edging of the medians along NE 114th Street & 7th Ave as well as all large medians.
- Mowed, edged & weed-eating both the Ballfield and the Recreation Center
- Trimmed a few low hanging branches located at NE 9th Avenue near the baseball diamond at the Rec Center
- Cleared an overgrown vacant lot at 11140 NE Griffing Blvd
- Clear two street lights that had a few overgrown branches around them at 777 NE 111th Street & 500 NE 119th Street
- Cleaned out the catch basins at NE 9th Ave between 115th & 116th Street
- All newly planted trees at the Rec. Center have been watered.
- Setup for a Special Commission Meeting
- Had to replace a defective car battery in the Ford Ranger
- Brought supplies that will be used at this weekend's Oktoberfest to the Rec. Center
- Tested the light tower to make sure it was functioning as it should be for Oktoberfest.
- Worked with Waste Pro to have all oversized piles and any that were left behind on Monday removed.

- **ADMINISTRATION:**

Manager continues to work with the Village Attorney and FEMA regarding debris reimbursement. Working with auditor regarding items for 2019 audit. Attended Special Commission meeting, Communication Workshop. Assisted residents as needed.
