The victim doesn't recall the last place he seen the weapon, but knows he kept the Glock, Model 27, 40 mm in the glove compartment of his personal vehicle. MDPD teletype has been notified. Vehicle showed no signs of forced entry. Detective investigating further.
- On Monday, October 22, 2019, officers responded to an accident with injuries on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Northwest 119 Street. There was property damage to the center median. Driver responsible for damages was cited.
- We continue to assist the State Attorney and the Public Defender's Office with records request and reviews of police files, the property room, etc.

- **PARKS & RECREATION:**  
Parks and Rec. Manager worked on Election Coordination. Promotions for new programming at the Rec. Center. Preparations for the Youth Flag Football program. Coordinated Hurricane Michael Relief collections in conjunction with Commissioner Sally Heyman's office. Worked on preparations and set up for the Halloween Funhouse. Mowed entrance sign NE 113<sup>th</sup> St. and 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. Watered all newly planted trees and landscaping. Treated median on 114<sup>th</sup> for chinch bugs and watered the lawn as well as the plantings on that median.
