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5 **A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COMMISSION**
6 **OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA;**
7 **ESTABLISHING THE SOLID WASTE NON-AD**
8 **VALOREM ASSESSMENT AMOUNT FOR THE**
9 **VILLAGE OF BISCAYNE PARK, FLORIDA FOR**
10 **THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OCTOBER 1,**
11 **2019; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION AND**
12 **SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN**
13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

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15 **WHEREAS**, Section 4.09 of the Village of Biscayne Park (the “Village”) Code of
16 Ordinances authorizes the Village to impose assessments on services and utilities;
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18 **WHEREAS**, Section 4.03 of the Village Code of Ordinances mandates that levying
19 taxes or appropriating funds shall require an ordinance;
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21 **WHEREAS**, on May 5, 2015, the Village adopted Ordinance No. 2015-02, authorizing
22 the imposition of a solid waste management fee assessment on an annual basis;
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24 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2015-02 was codified in Section 17.4 of the Village’s
25 Land Development Code;
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27 **WHEREAS**, the Village of Biscayne Park utilizes Miami-Dade County Office of the
28 Property Appraiser, Administrative Division (hereinafter referred to as the “County”) to
29 disclose the anticipated annual solid waste fee assessment on the County’s TRIM notices to
30 residents, and collect the Village’s annual solid waste fee assessment utilizing the County’s
31 property tax bills to residents;
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33 **WHEREAS**, the goal of this administration is to continue providing top level service to
34 the residents of the Village;
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36 **WHEREAS**, the Village Administration has completed a thorough assessment of the
37 projected budget and determined the necessary dollars needed to provide Village residents with
38 the services as they relate to sanitation and waste management;
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40 **WHEREAS**, the assessed properties are found to be specially benefitted by the
41 provision of solid waste collection services;
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43 **WHEREAS**, the estimated solid waste non-ad valorem assessment for 2019 will be
44 \$423.48 per residential unit, which is \$16.52 more than the 2019 fiscal year based on the
45 anticipated increase to the Village’s annual Sanitation budget from \$501,929 to \$530,290;
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47 **WHEREAS**, on June 18, 2019, the Village advertised a public hearing in the Daily
48 Business Review (DBR Ad No. 0000407792-01) to give notice of the proposed increase to the
49 annual non-ad valorem assessment for solid waste;

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2 **WHEREAS**, on June 18, 2019, the Village also mailed notices of the proposed
3 increase to the annual non-ad valorem assessment for solid waste to potentially-affected
4 residents;

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6 **WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2019, the Village held a public hearing in Village Hall on the
7 proposed increase to the solid waste assessment, as previously advertised and noticed;
8 **NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE**
9 **COMMISSION OF THE VILLAGE OF BISCAWAYNE PARK, FLORIDA:**

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11 **Section 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as
12 being true and correct and hereby made a specific part of this Resolution upon adoption hereof.

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14 **Section 2.** The Finance Director is authorized to submit to Miami-Dade County, no
15 later than September 15, 2019, a certified final roll for solid waste non-ad valorem assessment
16 of \$423.48 per residential unit, which is \$16.52 more than 2018, based on the estimated
17 increase of the annual Sanitation budget to \$530,290.00.

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19 **Section 3.** The Finance Director is also to provide the County with the data file
20 containing folio numbers with district information, which will be placed on the Village
21 residents' annual property tax bills from the County.

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23 **Section 4.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
