#### **RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS:**

Question 1. What day is recycling day? **Answered on Addendum # 2 – Answer # 16.**

Question 2. Does the Village require all yard waste to be bagged, containerized or bundled?  
**No.**

Question 3. The Village responded to a question confirming that each resident is allowed up to 2 cubic yards per week of yard waste. Yet in Section 2.3 (a) it states the need for mechanical collection and describes a 4 cubic yard pile. Can the Village clarify the limit allowed for each residential unit for yard waste? **Correction to RFP: Section 2.2 (a) should say: 3' X 3' X 6'. The size should say 2 cubic yards.**

Question 4. If the resident exceeds the limit of the yard waste, what are the procedures? **Public Works is notified, measure and work with homeowners to: reduce, remove or pay for service contractor to remove.**

Question 5. Does the proposer bill the village directly for the overage inward waste or if limb exceed over 5 feet, are greater than 50 pounds and exceed 6 inches in diameter. **No.**

Question 6. How is the recycling collection provided today? Automated or semi automated?  
**Semi-automated.**

Question 7. Do all resident have 64 gallon carts for recycling? **Answered on Addendum # 2 – Answer # 4**

Question 8. If not all the residents have a 64 gallon cart, how are they being serviced? **Using 35 gallons**

Question 9. Can the City clarify if there are 25 cents rebate or not? Answer 11(a) and 31 seem to contradict each other. **Not identified.**

Question 10. Can the proposer provide mechanical type collection for bulk? **Upon request**

Question 11. Can the proposer provide mechanical type collection for ~~years~~ yard waste regardless of limit? **Upon request**

Question 12. Will the Village accept additional proposal with alternative routing days while still providing all service levels in the RFP? **Answered on Addendum # 2 – Answer # 17**

Question 13. Will the Village allow the use of a subcontractor for the Household Hazardous Waste Alternate Proposal? **To be negotiated.**
